## Registration Fee

**Overseas participants:** The registration fee is ₩350,000 (Korean Won) or \$350.00, inclusive of all meals, tea/coffee/snacks for session breaks, conference banquets, field trip, and other social activities. The fee also covers the accommodations for 4 nights (from October 8 to 12, 2008). We will reserve hotels near the conference venue, Cheongju University. Participant's spouse is charged ₩150,000, inclusive of all privileges as described above. The registration fee can be paid (preferably in Korean currency) at the registration desk of Cheongju University from 16:00 of October 8.

**Korean participants:** The registration fee is ₩100,000, inclusive of all meals, tea/coffee/snacks for session breaks, conference banquets, and other social activities. It does not cover the fees for accommodation and field trip. There is an extra fee, ₩50,000, for field trip (₩20,000 for Oct. 10 and ₩30,000 for Oct. 11). We may arrange your accommodations by request on a daily fee basis.

## Hotel Information

**Hotel in Cheongju:** We reserved 4 small hotels that are close each other within one block and near Cheongju University. It takes about 15 minutes by walk from hotels to the conference site of Cheongju University. Among the hotels, the main place is Hotel Cinema. Every participants who arrive in Cheongju after 2 pm on Oct. 8 visit the lobby of Hotel Cinema first, and pay the registration fee to our conference staff at the registration desk. Then pick up your registration package and ask your hotel name and room number to the conference staff. You will stay 3 nights in that assigned hotel. The address of Hotel Cinema is Uam-dong 343-9, Sangdang-gu, Cheongju and the phone number is (043) 258-5555 (Do not expect the front desk can answer to your question in foreign language).

**Hotel in Seoul:** We reserved 3 hotels near Insa-dong, downtown Seoul for one night only on Oct. 11. One hotel (Hotel Crown) is not close from other two hotels (Hotel the Sunbee and Hotel SaeRim), which are close each other but two blocks apart from Hotel Crown. The phone numbers are as follows:

## Opening Ceremony (5:00 pm, Oct. 8)

**Goongjeon Buffet Restaurant:** This restaurant is only 3 minutes apart by walk from Hotel Cinema. After 4 pm on Oct. 8, the registration desk at the lobby of Hotel Cinema moves to this restaurant. If you arrive at the Hotel after 4 pm, please come to Goongjeon Buffet Restaurant directly and proceed your registration. At 5 pm, the opening ceremony starts in the restaurant.

**Opening Ceremony:** There will be an opening address by Prof. Hak-Hoon KIM (Chairman of the Organizing Committee), a welcome address by Dr. Yoon-Bae KIM (President of Cheongju University), and a welcome address by Prof. Woo-ik YU (Secretary-General of the International Geographical Union).

**Plenary Session:** Each president of the geographical societies of Korea, China, and Japan give a speech on the cooperation of geographers from three countries. Prof. Guoyou ZHANG (Secretary-General, The Geographical Society of China; in behalf of the President, Prof. Dadao LU), Prof. Toru TANIUCHI (President, The Association of Japanese Geographers) and Prof. Min-Boo Lee (President, The Korean Geographical Society) will give speeches to all conference participants.

## Business Meeting (12:00-13:00, Oct. 9)

All members of the Organizing Committee and the delegates of Korea-China-Japan participants are expected to meet together for business talk.

## Presentation

**Oral Presentation:** The presentation of each paper will be given up to 20 minutes. We suggest you to present for 15 minutes and leave 5 minutes for discussion. Conference rooms are equipped with a PC and a beam projector. You are welcome to use Microsoft PowerPoint to aid your presentation. Please note that overhead projectors (OHPs) will not be available for your presentation. If you intend to utilize PowerPoint slides, please bring your USB memory stick saving your PPT file.

**Poster Presentation:** We will provide 60cm(W)X90cm(H) foam board for each poster. If your poster is bigger than that size, we will post it directly on the wall. The authors of posters are supposed to bring their posters to the conference hall in the morning on Oct. 9 (Thursday), and then their posters will be displayed from noon of Oct. 9 to noon of Oct.10. The official poster session is scheduled from 17:00-18:00 on Oct. 9, and all authors of posters are expected to be present during the poster session.

## About Cheongju



Cheongju (or Chongju) is an inland city located 128km from south of Seoul. It is known as a "city of education and culture." It is also a center of politics, economy, tourism and administration, with the provincial office of Chungcheongbuk-do (Chungbuk) Province located here. The city has a population of about 640,000 and four 4-year universities. Manufacturing is an important income source for the residents in Cheongju, where a industrial complex is located.

## About Cheongju University

Cheongju (or Chongju) University is an old private university that started in 1947. The University is located near downtown Cheongju. Once you arrive in Cheongju bus terminal, you can take a taxi (fare is approximately 5,000 Won) or you can catch a bus No.500 or No.513 to the University. It takes about 20 - 30 minutes to get to the University.

## From China

Cheongju International Airport has regular connections between Shanghai(Pudong) and Shenyang. Chinese participants can arrive Cheongju International Airport directly from Chinese major cities or via Incheon International Airport and take limousine bus to Cheongju bus terminal.

## From Japan

Even though Cheongju International Airport is in operation, there is no regular line between Cheongju and Japanese cities. Japanese participants are advised to go to the Incheon International Airport and take limousine bus to Cheongju bus terminal. There is regular bus connections between Incheon International Airport and Cheongju bus terminal in every 30 minutes (fare is 19,000 Won).
